The waves of the ocean break, one after another, to make the rising tide. So the years here at San Pasqual follow one after another, each representing a step toward maturity and adulthood.

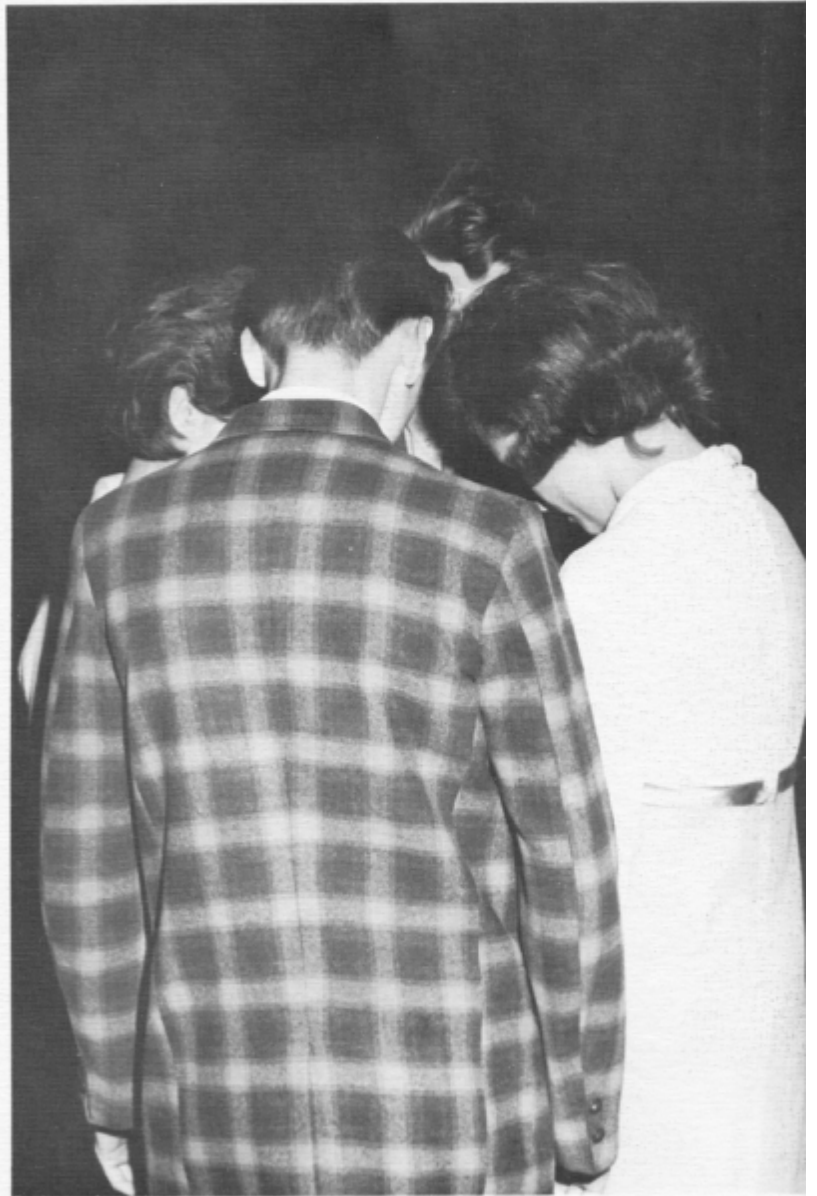
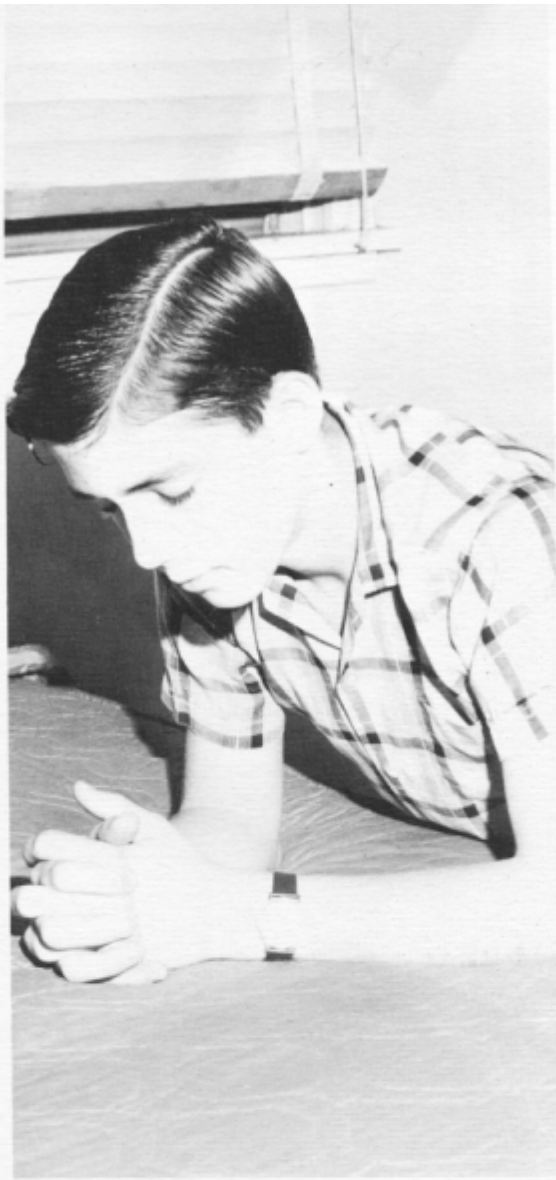
The undercurrents of the ocean make it strong and powerful. So the cultivation of young minds make our school and our nation strong.
