SPA's 60th. Alumni Reunion!

One final note: The Board and the catering staff will allow a very limited number of individuals to pay at the door, but the charge will be \$13.00 per meal. This is only for hardship cases that did not receive this message, or the E-mail Newsletter. We can only provide "pay at the door meals" for up to ten (10) people. The Board hopes you understand the restrictions of providing a catered meal, and thanks you in advance for your timely checks.

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President's Message

First of all I want to apologize for the tardiness of this newsletter. But, I want you to know that it was out of our control. We had the best intentions to get the newsletter out by the end of January. However, we have had some slow delay in return communication with the new school for confirmation on the date for the reunion. Also there was some thought of the new school not allowing us to have the catered lunch on campus. We have since resolved this and the date is set in stone. I am truly grateful and pleased that we will be able to have another reunion at our beloved campus. This would have been SPA's 60th Anniversary had the school remained open

Last July we received the completed order of the Grove tables, they are all in place and I must admit they look great! Between July '08 and April '09 the school made some changes in the Grove and due to all the construction going on a "Fire Access" road was placed and it runs through the grove area but, overall it's still the same Grove and looking better with all the tables. Again, I want to thank all those that made the "Grove Table Project" happen.

This year has been a very busy one for all of us and the economy has not helped. But, I am glad that the association is still going strong. Some of my goals that I had set last year to be completed are coming together. My first goal was to reach over 1000 alumni registered on the SPA website and I am pleased to announce that we have just hit 1086 members registered online! Some of this was helped by getting SPAAA on "Facebook". Our webmaster and V.P. got us registered onto Facebook and that same weekend we had close to 100 new alumni signing up. Great job, Danny! My second goal was to develop an SPA Alumni Scholarship / Grant Program. This program would be available to SPA Alumni member's children and open to the students of the new school. We the Board have agreed upon a \$1000.00 Scholarship/Grant per school year. This Scholarship/Grant may be awarded as one lump sum to one worthy student or divided into two \$500.00 Scholarship/Grants for two worthy students. Because of the time frame we have sent the proposal to the new school and we are awaiting word back from them. We are hoping to be able to present the first Scholarship/Grant at their graduation in June. In doing this I would hope the new school will see that we truly want to give back to the school and create a concrete relationship with them. This would help in not having to wait for an evaluation before allowing us to have the alumni reunion on the campus.

Some of my goals for this next year are:

- would like to see 2000 alumni registered online
- I would like to see an annual golf tournament
- Would like to possibly have a two day alumni reunion. It could either be a Friday – Saturday, having a vespers on Friday night or Saturday – Sunday, having a softball game on Sunday. This would be a great attraction for those that come from a distance.
- Would like to get financial help for the Association from the "Southeastern Conference"
- Have a Class Coordinator's for every class.

I know these goals will need some hard work to get them accomplished, but we need to keep the association strong in order to keep it alive! If you have any ideas and/or would like to help in any way please contact a board member. If you did not see a coordinator for your class, please seriously consider becoming a class coordinator. You do not have to live in California or close to the school to be a class coordinator. Many coordinators are from other states and you can and do ask other alumni or board members that live near the school if you need help. Remember the longer a class goes without a coordinator, the more classmates are lost from future contact.

I hope as many as possible will be able to attend the Alumni Reunion this year. It is always good to see so many familiar faces and it's great to meet new ones.
